The following is the Senate PROCLAMATION
concerning the STRIKE.

The Student Senate expresses a student strike to be held May 5th and 6th express disgust and horror by the recent killings at Kent State University. We feel that the issue that those four students died for do exemplify the overwhelming majority of Americans. It is for this reason that the Student Senate also enforces any peaceful demonstrations of any magnitude that takes place on the Pittsburgh State Campus or any such institution.

Everyone is requested to: (1) wear black arm bands; (2) bring posters, signs, megaphones etc. (3) dress warmly; (4) SPREAD THE WORD!!!

This will be the route the parade follows:
From McDonough Hall down Broad Street, to Route #9, then to the shopping center adjacent to the U.S. Air Base.
