I am writing to request a Parade Permit on behalf of the Student Association and other interested parties of the college and community for the evening of May 6, 1970. This march is to further express the disgust and horror engendered by Monday's killings at Kent State. It is also to show support for the ideals and principles these students died for - ideals and principles we feel are shared by the majority of Americans.

Details of the march are as follows. The approximate number of persons anticipated is 2500. We plan to depart from Macdonough Hall at 9:00 p.m. We will proceed from the said location down Broad Street to Route 9 and then to the Shopping Center adjacent to the U.S. Air Base.

Marchers in the parade are to move in an organized manner in order to allow traffic to proceed as normally as possible. Mayor Steltzer and President Angell will be among the marchers.

An open invitation to participate is extended to all members of the College and the community at large.
